You will be provided a copy for guidance. The event must stay within all outlined boundaries. Any additional events outside of the dates/times approved by the U.S. Coast Guard will require separate approval and/or permitting. The Sponsor must also obtain approval from all Federal, State, and/or Local agencies that have jurisdiction and concerns where the marine event is to take place. The Sponsor shall maintain a copy of this permit for the entire event. If questioned by public officials or law enforcement, the Sponsor must be able to produce a copy of the signed permit. In addition, please ensure the following:</p> <p>-- Participants shall adhere to event safety guidelines and wear appropriate life jackets while on the water and throughout the course. The U.S. Coast Guard, State, and Local law enforcement agencies will assist in monitoring appropriate life jacket wear & overall safety of the event.</p> <p>-- Any Sponsor event vessels must be easily identifiable and cleared with the Bullhead City Police Incident Command Post.</p> <p>-- Adherence to your event plans and provisions received by the Coast Guard in correspondence dated July 24, 2018, July 26, 2018 and July 30, 2018 to include but not limited to your: trash mitigation plan, safety plan, alcohol mitigation plan, and Inscription Rock protection plan.</p> <p>-- Provide after event cleanup documentation to include a synopsis and pictures of land, top of water, and river bottom trash pickup within 30 days of the event conclusion.</p> <p>-- Provide identification of the following endangered fresh-water fish to all personnel so that anyone seeing these type of fish shall report this to the event sponsor who will report to Fish and Wildlife: Bonytail (<i>Gila elegans</i>) and Razorback sucker (<i>Xyrauchen texanus</i>).</p> <p style="text-align: right;">(Cont'd Page 2)</p>
